#### Reading

Throughout this school year, we have been engaging all our young people in some of their favourite books and authors. The children are continually listening to and responding to their books, stories both fiction and non-fiction. Reading is a vital life skill that we want to develop and grow. Creating a love for reading is our aim and in the words of Dr Suess, 'The more that you read, the more things you will know, The more that you learn, the more places you will go.' The expectation is that each child should be reading daily at home. Each child's Reading Record must be signed by parents/carers. KS2 children to record any other books they read from the class/school library or from home. Reading books will be changed once children have had quality time reading their book, they may explore further questions relating to the book, record personal responses and must ensure they have re-read all of the book.

Our school uniform aims to create a sense of belonging and raises the profile of the school image. Therefore we would like to remind parents that we have very clear expectations.
