Dear Parents,

Thank you for the great attendance at **parents evening** last night. The teachers appreciated the excellent turnout and opportunity to discuss your children's progress. If parents were unable to attend

due to work commitments the staff will be very happy to arrange an appointment before or after school one evening next week.

The **reading meeting for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 parents** will take place next Thursday 19th October at 3.00pm and Friday 20th October at 9.00am in the school hall. Parents only need to attend one of the meetings. This is a great opportunity to hear the infant staff explain how they teach phonics and reading and the strategies you can use to help them at home. A letter has been sent home for parents to indicate if they are able to attend.

It is important that when children attend any **medical appointments** for the dentist, doctor or hospital during school hours, proof of the appointment is brought to the school office. This is to ensure that your child's non-attendance at school is not marked as an unauthorised absence. Doctors' surgeries will provide a headed slip with the time of your child's appointment. This is in line with the attendance policy of all Whitefield schools and following Bury council policy.
