

Dear Parents,

We are now moving into the season of **Advent**- the four weeks before Christmas. The television adverts and shops make us believe that Christmas has arrived already, however, we know this is not so. We have to prepare and get ourselves ready for the celebration of Jesus' birth. Please read with your child the colourful Wednesday Word sheets which go out every week. These will help them understand the significance of the season. For adults there is an opportunity to prepare by spending time in front of the Blessed Sacrament so that we can pay attention to God and ourselves. This year's Advent Exposition will be held each Wednesday starting on the 6th December from 3.15-4.15pm

and 5.00-6.00pm at St Michael's church and from 11am-12 before every Saturday Mass in the Lourdes Room at St Bernadette's church.

On Sunday 17th December 4-6pm children and adults are invited to come along and enjoy working together on a number of creative arts and crafts activities with an Advent focus. These craft making activities, which include making Christingles, will take place in St Bernadette's Parish Centre. A service will be held at St Bernadette's church after the craft event where children can bring along their Christingles and have their cribs blessed. This special celebration will be followed by refreshments in the Parish centre.

The **sacramental programme** for the Year 3 children continues this Sunday 3rd December after the 9.30am Mass. A separate reminder note has gone out this week with all children.
